



SUPPORTING GRADE 9 LEARNERS TO SHAPE THEIR FUTURE



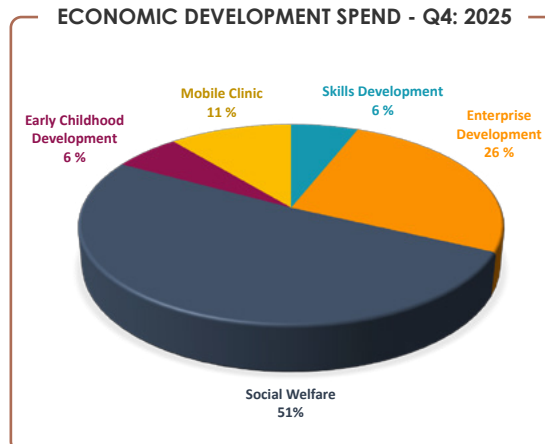
At the end of 2025, we rolled out a Career Guidance and Leadership Development Programme for Grade 9 learners, aimed at supporting informed subject and career choices.

The programme reached 646 learners across six high schools, providing a safe, interactive space for self-discovery and future planning. Through engaging training modules, Knowing Yourself, Subject vs Career Choices, and Journey Mapping, learners explored their strengths, interests, and aspirations while gaining practical guidance on choosing suitable subjects for future careers.

Learners were also introduced to key concepts such as APS scores, bursaries, tertiary pathways, and career planning tools.

"It's vital that learners are guided early, as Grade 9 subject choices shape future opportunities," said Lesego Mosiane, Social Performance Practitioner for Matla A Bokone Solar.

MOBILE CLINIC BRINGS ESSENTIAL PRIMARY HEALTH- CARE TO LEARNERS

Our Mobile Health Clinic programme continues to strengthen access to quality primary healthcare for learners across the project area. During last year's cycle, the programme provided primary healthcare, dental, and optometry screenings, alongside health education sessions focusing on bullying, healthy nutrition, substance abuse, and teenage pregnancy.

A total of 21 schools were reached and 2,369 beneficiaries received healthcare screenings. This included 93 optometry referrals and 153 spectacles issued, 27 dental referrals with 48 extractions, and 63 primary healthcare referrals, ensuring early detection and timely support for learners in need.

Beyond screenings, learners participated in health education talks aimed at promoting informed lifestyle choices and long-term wellbeing.
